INTERNATIONAL MULTIDISCIPLINARY CONFERENCE ON SUFISM AND MODERN SCIENCES

November 22-23, 2022

The University of Sufism and Modern Sciences (USMS) Bhitshah organized a conference titled as "International Multidisciplinary Conference on Sufism and Modern Sciences" on 22-23 November 2022.

The conference received a total of 154 papers from different parts of Pakistan. The conference committee accepted 93 papers for presentation in conference. 72 researchers have presented their research work in parallel session organized in USMS. 21 researchers presented their papers through ONLINE mode. Five international keynote speakers and ten national keynote speakers graced the conference by sharing their research work.
